
The Marshall Fire Department respectfully requests the authorization to purchase a Pierce, Enforcer, Pumper from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group in the amount of \$596,380.00. The related equipment including but not limited to rescue tools, thermal imaging camera, large diameter hoses, and self contained breathing apparatus (SCBAs) will be purchased in the amount of \$93,620.00. As part of the budget process and requests for capital equipment slated for 2016, the Marshall Fire Department requested this equipment as part of its intentions of replacing its aging fleet of fire apparatus.

This apparatus will provide the capabilities of a pumper with a cascade system, and compressed air foam system (CAFS) and also utilized as a heavy rescue unit. By implementing a unit such as this, the fire department will eliminate three (3) pieces of equipment as this is a 3 in 1 unit.

In an effort to ensure the agreed upon and stated terms and conditions, Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC requires an authorized individual from the purchasing organization to sign and date the proposal and include it with an approved purchase order. This commitment begins the process of building our pumper and also avoids any projected 2016 price increases. Please note it takes approximately 10 to 12 months to take delivery and we will not begin any payments until a year after delivery.

We are considering any potential cost saving measures pertaining to needed and related equipment as well as installation necessities. The total package of bids for the new pumper and related equipment including HGAC pricing, delivery and operation instructions is \$690,000.00.
