

ORDINANCE NO. 0-05-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 ADMINISTRATION THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS, BY ENACTING A NEW SECTION 2-10 ENTITLED CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES; ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS; REPORTING OF ATTENDANCE; AND, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby enacted a new section to Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall, Texas, entitled "Section 2-10, City appointed boards, commissions, and committees: Attendance requirements; reporting requirements" said section to read as follows:

"Sec. 2-10. City appointed boards, commissions, and committees; Attendance requirements; reporting of attendance.

- a) Members are expected to be available to attend most board or committee meetings. All members of any board, commission, or committee shall be present at 75% of all scheduled meetings per calendar year. (January 1 to December 31) A member, who misses more than 25% of the meetings of a board or commission within a calendar year, excluding excused absences, shall automatically forfeit his or her position. (Excused absences shall be determined by the board chair and said determination may be appealed to the City Commission.) This section shall apply to all city boards, commissions, and committees except where federal law, state law or City Charter provisions conflict.
- b) Each board, commission, or committee shall maintain attendance records for its members, and shall on a quarterly basis forward those attendance records to the city manager or the city manager's designee for review and tabulation.

Section 2. That the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act (Texas Government Code Chapter 551).

Section 3. That, except as expressly provided otherwise herein, this ordinance shall be cumulative of all ordinances of the City of Marshall, Texas, as amended; provided, however, that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict only.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
