**WHEREAS**, under and by virtue of a Resolution passed, approved, and adopted by the City Commission on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January, 2016 and thereafter published, an election was held in said City on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016 for the purpose of electing District Commissioners five, six and seven.
