**Marshall Clean Sweep** – our program to focus cleanup efforts in a specified neighborhood or area of Marshall is set for the 5<sup>th</sup> of November. This program is accomplished through volunteer efforts of City Staff, City Commissioners, local clubs and organizations, and the MISD’s AVID Program.

**Quarterly Cleanup Programs** – in addition to our current quarterly neighborhood Clean Sweep Event, we are also sponsoring our next quarterly city-wide residential “free” dump day on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM until Noon at our City Convenience Station at 2300 Five Notch Road (east of Hwy. 59).




