Re: Proposed site for location of new Animal Shelter facility

At the request of the City Commission, City Staff has completed additional research regarding proposed sites for a new Animal Shelter facility. The landowners of two properties located on Hwy. 59 North were contacted regarding the possible purchase of their properties. However, the sale price for each of these properties is cost-prohibitive.

As previously reported to the Commission, a suitable site for a new Animal Shelter facility is the City-owned property located on Hwy. 43 North. This site provides a foliage barrier and direct Hwy. 43 access. This property also provides several other advantages, such as a private drive, sound suppression, and room for future expansion. An aerial map of this location is attached.

It is the recommendation of the City Staff that we utilize the City-owned property located on Hwy. 43 North as the location of a new Animal Shelter facility.
