Subject: Consider official ratification of the Disaster Declaration dated May 14, 2015

On May 14, 2015 a Declaration of Disaster was submitted to the Texas Department of Emergency Management, as a result of damages caused in the City from recent flooding. While the Mayor may declare a disaster, we are asking that the Commission, as a Body, ratify this Declaration of Disaster as part of the ongoing process. A copy of this document is attached.

DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Marshall, Texas on the 14th day of May, 2015 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from damaging flooding and;

WHEREAS, the judge of the City of Marshall, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR/JUDGE OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City of Marshall, Texas.
2. That the City/County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the City of Marshall, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
