The purpose of this Resolution is to allow Marshall ISD an opportunity to comply with Section 11.0581 of the Texas Education Code requiring all school board trustee elections to be held as a joint election with either the governing body of a municipality located in the school district or the governing body of the political subdivision for state and county officers in which that district resides. The joint election is also provided for in Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code.

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT WITH MARSHALL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE MAY 5, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Marshall, Texas agrees to enter into a Joint Election Agreement for the May 5, 2018 election with Marshall Independent School District and;

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution being to allow Marshall ISD an opportunity to comply with Section 11.0581 of the Texas Education Code requiring all school board trustee elections to be held as a joint election with either the governing body of a municipality located in the school district or the governing body of the political subdivision for state and county officers in which that district resides and;

WHEREAS, elections held on the same date as provided by Texas Education Code Section 11.0581 shall be held as a joint election under Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code.
