PROJECT: Act and respond to a report regarding the 3rd Quarter Clean Sweep Program and Free Dump Day scheduled for Saturday, September 10th. (Public Services Director and Clean Sweep Committee)

DESCRIPTION: On Saturday, September 10th, 2016 the City will host our 3rd quarterly Clean Sweep Program for this year. The area of concentration this period, will be the southwest quadrant of Marshall, bounded in general by Pinecrest, southward along Highway 43, to our southern city limits, then along our southeastern city limit along FM-31 and back to Highway 59 (see attached Notice and Flyer).

In addition, we will also be holding of quarterly Free Dump Day at the City Convenience Station on Five Notch Road (see attached Flyer).

In advance of the Clean Sweep Program on September 10th, our Public Works Department began clean ups of high traffic intersections on Highway 59 at Highway 43 South, Highway 80, and Highway 43 North (see pictures below).





Our crews have also been working to improve the safety aspect of the traffic triangles at Highway 59 South and Interstate 20, by trimming the trees up 6'- 0" to provide better visibility of traffic as you exit and enter Interstate 20 (see pictures below).





We are planning to insert the Clean Sweep and Free Dump Day flyers in our water bills to assist in increasing participation.



Clean Sweep Area for September






