A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,777.00 FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE 2016 GRANT YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Marshall Police Department intends to apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for the 2016 grant year in the amount of \$11,777.00; and

WHEREAS, the Marshall Police Department intends to use the grant for the purchase of equipment in compliance with the terms and conditions of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the equipment purchased with the grant fund will assist the Marshall Police Department in providing its officers with up to date equipment that is in keeping with modern and current law enforcement standards and practices;

The Commission of the City of Marshall hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$11,777.00 for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for the 2016 grant year.

The Commission of the City of Marshall confirms that the Marshall Police Department intends to use the grant for the purchase of equipment in compliance with the terms and conditions of the grant to assist the Marshall Police Department in providing its officers with up to date equipment that is in keeping with modern and current law enforcement standards and practices.

The findings set forth in the preamble to this resolution are hereby in all things approved.
