**Effective Immediately**

Following changes that were made by the Texas Department of State Health Services to the food establishment guidelines, the City of Marshall will no longer be able to offer food handler classes.

While we will no longer be hosting classes at the Marshall Convention Center, State law still requires that all food establishment employees have a food handler card, and there must be at least one Certified Food Manager.

The course can be taken online through various State approved websites, as well as in person through Panola College, 1300 E. Pinecrest Dr. #126, Marshall, TX 75670.

The class at Panola College will meet the third Saturday of the month, 8 to 11 a.m.
