
90. ORDINANCE O-12-02: CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION REGARDING REDUCING THE RATE OF THE LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF MARSHALL DEDICATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF A TYPE A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FROM ONE-HALF (1/2) OF ONE PERCENT TO THREE-EIGHTHS (3/8) OF ONE PERCENT, AND ADOPTING A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX IN THE CITY OF MARSHALL AT THE RATE OF ONE-EIGHTH (1/8) OF ONE PERCENT TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS

Commissioner Timmins moved to approve an Ordinance calling a Special Election regarding reducing the rate of the local sales and use tax in the City of Marshall dedicated for the benefit of a Type A Economic Development Corporation from one-half (1/2) of one percent to three-eighths (3/8) of one percent, and adopting a local sales and use tax in the City of Marshall at the rate of one-eighth (1/8) of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. Commissioner Moon seconded the motion, which passed by a 6:0 vote.
