



City of Marshall Municipal Court relocates to Business Development Center

The City of Marshall Municipal Court, located at 303 W. Burseson (the old police and fire building), is now housed inside the Business Development Center, 110 S. Bolivar St., Suite 104-B on the first floor.

The move will allow the court to improve operational efficiency and convenience for Marshall citizens, and allow the court to be housed in a location that is more modernized than the current location, which has been plagued with maintenance issues for a number of years.

“Our current court has experienced a lot of wear and tear over the years and hasn’t aged gracefully and it’s just not conducive for our needs. By relocating to the Business Development Center, we will be able to provide better service to our citizens in a better, more sustainable space. It is clear that the old courtroom facility has reached its service lifespan and our new courtroom will allow us to conduct business and serve the public in a safer, more aesthetically pleasing environment,” said City Manager Mark Rohr.

The new court is comprised of a modern judicial bench, plaintiff/counsel area, jury table, witness box and public seating area, as well as advanced technological and security features that create a safe and inviting atmosphere for the public.
