Marshall residents to receive flyer in the mail containing information regarding changes to garbage collection, recycling services

Marshall residents will soon begin receiving flyers in the mail containing information regarding changes to garbage collection and recycling services that are provided to city residents by Republic Services. Flyers will also be available at Marshall City Hall, 401 S. Alamo Blvd., and on the city's website at www.marshalltexas.net.

The flyer will detail a new garbage and recycling collection schedule that will begin on Monday, Feb. 4, 2019. Garbage and recycling collection will occur once per week. Republic Services will deliver 96-gallon rolling garbage and recycle carts (one of each) to all Marshall residents who do not currently have garbage or recycling carts at no cost beginning the last week of this month. Business customers who utilize curbside service will also receive carts at no cost. Customers who currently have a garbage and/or recycle cart will have the carts fees removed from their bill.

The new collection schedule will be as follows:

- Monday – addresses east of State Highway 59—including even-numbered addresses on State Highway 59 (Yellow area depicted on the map)
- Tuesday – addresses north of Pinecrest Dr.; west of State Highway 59; and south of State Highway 80—including odd-numbered addresses on State Highway 59 and Pinecrest and even-numbered addresses on State Highway 80 (Orange area depicted on the map)
- Wednesday – city wide recycle pick-up
- Thursday – addresses north of State Highway 80; and west of State Highway 59—including odd-numbered addresses on State Highway 80 (Pink area depicted on the map)
- Friday – addresses south of Pinecrest Dr.; and west of State Highway 59—including odd-numbered addresses on State Highway 59 and even-numbered addresses on Pinecrest. (Violet area depicted on the map)
- Downtown business owners will continue to have four days per week pick up

The flyer will address many of the questions that residents have asked relating to the change in garbage collection and recycling services such as how to acquire more carts, correct placement of garbage and recyclables, scheduling bulk pick up requests (which includes yard waste such as leaves and limbs), and correct cart placement for pick up by Republic Services. Carts must be out for collection no later than 7 a.m. on the morning of the scheduled service and must be removed within 24 hours of service. All garbage and recycle items must be placed in the rolling carts in order to be picked up and the cart lid must be closed. Overloaded carts will not be serviced.

Customers with disabilities or other physical limitations can contact Republic Services at 903-986-5324 if they are unable to roll their cart(s) to the street—a doctor's statement is required to utilize this service.
