A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS ANNOUNCING A PROPOSED TAX RATE OF \$0.542160 PER \$100 VALUATION AND VOTING TO PLACE AN ACTION ITEM TO ADOPT THE TAX RATE ON A FUTURE COMMISSION AGENDA

WHEREAS, the Tax Code of the State of Texas requires the governing body to announce a tax rate and schedule and announce the date and time to adopt a tax rate if the tax rate exceeds the effective tax rate or rollback rate, whichever is lower; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of Marshall proposes to adopt a tax rate of \$0.542160 per \$100 valuation for the City's 2016 Budget which exceeds the effective tax rate; and,

WHEREAS, since the proposed tax rate will exceed the effective tax rate; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS:



A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARINGS ON A PROPOSED TAX RATE OF \$0.542160 PER \$100 VALUATION AND A TAX INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of the State of Texas requires the governing body to conduct two public hearings if the tax rate exceeds the lower of the effective tax rate or rollback rate, and results in a total tax revenue increase; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of Marshall proposes to adopt a tax rate of \$0.542160 per \$100 valuation for the City's 2016 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tax rate will exceed the effective tax rate and result in a tax increase; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL, TEXAS:


