The City of Marshall Fire Department is accepting registration forms to establish a list of eligible candidates to participate in a written civil service exam for the position of:

Entry Level Fire Fighter

****HIRING PREFERENCE MAY BE GIVEN TO CANDIDATES WHO CURRENTLY POSSESS A TDSHS EMT/PARAMEDIC CERTIFICATION****

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be at least 18 years of age and have not yet reached the age of 36 by the date of the written exam.
2. Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
3. Must possess a high school diploma or GED.
4. Must possess a valid driver license. Texas Class B driver license will be required after employment.

Preferred Professional Qualifications

1. Texas Commission on Fire Protection Basic Fire Fighter certification or higher.
2. Texas Department of State Health Services EMT or Paramedic certification.

Closing Date: April 29, 2016

Starting Salary: \$37,702 (Non-TCFP Certified) - \$41,312 (Non-TCFP + Paramedic)
\$39,179 (TCFP Certified) - \$42,779 (TCFP + Paramedic)
