This year, there is a new way to identify your library as a part of the Texas Public Library System, using the badge below. This can be used as a window cling, a website addition, or displayed prominently in the library.

As a system member, the benefits of accreditation include access to statewide interlibrary loan (ILL), grant funding, E-rate and TexShare card and database programs. Instructions on Ordering Window Sticker from vistaprint®

1. **Save the image for the sticker design** to your computer in a location where you will be able to find it later.
2. **Navigate to the web page:** https://www.vistaprint.com/signs-posters/window-decals?xnav=swsProductOnly_ResultTitle
3. **Select the following specifications** for your sticker:
 - Orientation: Horizontal
 - Size: 5" X 5"
 - Material: Cling (static, no adhesive)
 - Application Surface: Inside-glass
 - Background Option: Clear
 - Quantity: 1 - ?
 - Squeegee: 1 (free)
4. Click the **Start designing** button (below the specification choices), which will take you to a new page.
5. In the body of this page, select (click) the top left box with the option: **Use your complete design, Upload it.**
6. Under the heading **Image**, click **My computer**.
7. Navigate to the **sticker design file** you saved earlier, **select and upload it.**
8. The outer edges of the design (white circle) **should fit within the dotted safety line** on the mockup. If it does not fit, you can adjust the design on this mockup so that it does. You can also call a vistaprint® customer service representative for assistance. Their toll-free number is 866-207-4955.
 - Note: regarding the message associated with this mockup, because you have chosen the clear background option above, you will not have a white border around your design.
9. Click the **Next button** to navigate to the next page where you will see an image of how your design will look on a window.
10. If it looks good, **check the box approving your design**, then click the **Next button**.
11. Proceed to checkout.
